#### **TEAMS**

- Number 3: Judges

#### **TABOO TWIST**

- Each Debate Team will have a list of words they cannot say!
- Judges Team will be trying to trick the teams to say their Taboo Words

#### **POINTS**

- **Debate Teams:** At the end of each round Judges Team will get to vote for the team they think did best that round!
  - +1 → For every 2 votes
- Judges Team: +1 → Each time you get a debate team to say a Taboo word!
- Teams with the most number of points wins an EXTRA 0.5 SHC points for coming to this GBM!

## **Structure for Taboo Debate**

#### PREPARATION: 10 MIN

- Debate Teams: Develop your argument and identify how you want to approach your turns
- Judges Team: Brainstorm ways to trick the teams to say their taboo word during the debate

**DEBATE:** Rest of the Time

#### Round 1:

- Each Debate Team: 3 minutes to present your argument
- Judges Team: 5 minutes to ask questions of clarification after each team presents their argument

#### • Round 2:

- Each Debate Team: 5 minutes to refute the other team's argument and defend your argument
- o Judges Team: Same as Round 1
